The next Advanced Sommelier Certificate programme of lectures, tastings and examinations will be held at the Princess Victoria, 217 Uxbridge Road, Shepherd's Bush, London W12 9DH, from Sunday morning 20<sup>th</sup> July to Thursday late afternoon 24<sup>th</sup> July 2008. The course will commence at 8.30am each morning and finish at approximately 5.30pm in the evening.

The fee for this non-residential course is £455, or equivalent in foreign currency at time of dispatch, I am sure your bank will help with calculating the total amount. Payments can be made either with cheque or through the bank transfer system to the Court's account. Foreign currency cheques require an extra £11 bank negotiation fee. £150 will be held as a non-returnable deposit. The fee includes two coffee breaks per first three days, light lunch on Sunday and Monday, mineral water, badge and certificate for successful candidates.

If you are unable to pay the full fee immediately, please return the completed application form confirming the date by which payment can be made. The number of places available for this course is limited so they will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

On registration all new candidates will receive a small pamphlet, which will provide some guidance as to the preliminary work you will need to do and a list of local reasonably priced accommodation. To get the most out of the programme, studying and reading up on the wines of the world in advance is essential as it is impossible for anyone to learn and remember everything necessary during the three days of lectures. Take every opportunity to taste wines using the outline in the pamphlet. Tasting techniques and practical service will be well covered during the course and the programmes of lectures will cover the majority of the theoretical knowledge giving you the opportunity to ask questions about the various wines and other drinks. Please note that the level of the Advanced examination is much higher than the Introductory and Certified Sommelier examinations.
